- No spectators at events.
- All entries to be made online.
- Please do not attend the venue if you suspect you have any symptoms or been in contact with anyone that may have contracted Covid-19. For Symptoms, see Government Guidelines. Prior to leaving home all participants should take their own temperature and that of any accompanying person, if there is any doubt they should not attend.
- No persons from lockdown areas or regions of the country will be allowed to enter/compete.
- Times and Numbers are available on the website 2 days before the competition.
 PLEASE PRINT/MAKE YOUR OWN ALLOCATED RIDER NUMBER OR USE YOUR NUMBER DISK.
 NUMBERS WILL BE ALLOCATED WITH TIMES. THESE MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES AND MUST BE EASILY READABLE. ALL VEHICLES MUST DISPLAY THEIR ASSOCIATED RIDER
 NUMBER IN THEIR VEHICLE WINDSCREEN.
- You are expected to ride on your allocated times. If you do not do so, you risk being unable to compete. This applies to all competitors/users.
- Face masks must be worn indoors, except whilst riding.
- Please view online maps of the site layout at www.westwilts.com There are one way systems in place to access the arenas.
- All persons on site must adhere to the advice from the relevant sport national governing body.
- Government guidelines and advise on Social Distancing https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus must be adhered to.
- The toilets will be open but there is a <u>one in one out policy</u> in place. These will be serviced and cleaned regularly.
- Hand sanitising stations will be provided, and visitors are encouraged to take home their rubbish where possible.
- Please park considerately, a safe distance from each other. Current recommendations are 10m apart if there is tying up on both sides of your box; 5m where tying up is on one side, and 3m apart if no tying up is used. For busy show days there will be no tie up allowed.
- <u>ALL</u> DOGS MUST BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES, ANYONE WITH A LOOSE DOG <u>AT ANY</u> TIME WILL BE ASKED TO GO HOME.
- Point of contact will be in the office for essential communications only.

Warm Up Arenas

- SJ Warm up Max 6 PEOPLE –i.e. 5 riders and 1 groom/attendant or 4 riders and 2 grooms will be allowed; priority will be given to the attendants for the riders who are top of the list to go forward to the collecting ring.
- All grooms/attendants must sanitise hands before touching any poles, wings, cups etc.

- Dressage warm up, max numbers allowed will be displayed on the warm-up arenas.
- Warm up time will be limited by numbers allowed in arena to an estimated 20 minutes.
- We ask that competitors maintain social distancing when riding and, once you have finished competing, you leave the site as promptly as possible.
- All scores/results will be published online.
- Stamped addressed envelope can be left for rosettes and dressage sheets

PERSONS ALLOWED ON-SITE

Unaffiliated Events & British Eventing Competitions

- Each competitor is allowed to bring ONE additional supporting person per horse. This person must travel in the vehicle to the event with the rider and ideally be able to drive the vehicle and horse home in the event of an accident. If your supporting person is unable to drive the vehicle you MUST have made provisions to ensure the vehicle and horse can be removed from the venue. This supporting person must be available to help the rider alongside medical staff in the event of an accident if required.
- Owners 1 Owner per horse / 2 Owners per horse if from the same household. All owners must display their riders' numbers in their vehicle windscreens to gain access to the event, ALL OWNERS MUST COMPLETE PAGE 3 of THIS DOCUMENT and hand it in to Point of Contact/Office on arrival.
- Children A maximum of 2 x Children of 11yrs old or under (connected to the rider)
 may attend and must stay under the direct supervision of the support team and or
 owners. Children over 11 years of age may attend if competing or where they are the
 support person for the rider permitted by these protocols.
- U18 Riders (Youth) Two parents/guardians are allowed if absolutely necessary. If two
 parents attend, NO other owners are permitted.
- Riders and Support to bring their own PPE Face Coverings, Gloves and Hand Sanitiser
 to use in situations where Social Distancing is not possible (Retrieving injured or loose
 horses for example)

British Dressage Competitions

Rider plus one additional person per horse, plus under 18 regulations as above.

British Show Jumping Competitions

- Athletes may be accompanied by one other person and one additional person for every additional horse entered.
- At pony shows people in attendance are limited to one adult per child, and one additional person allowed for any additional ponies entered (as per horse shows)
